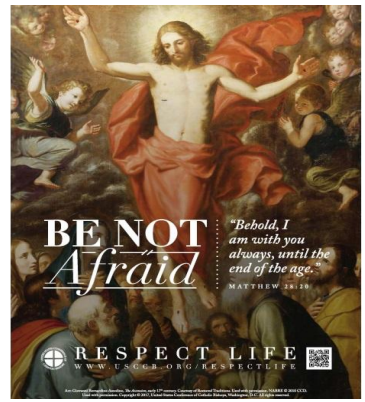


# Student/Senior Video Interview Category Form



- The goal of this video interview is to begin a dialogue between the student and senior about a Respect Life issue.
- The video interview must be recorded and kept to under 2 minutes 30 seconds.
- The video interview should be between the student and a senior citizen.
- The filming, audio, and editing of the video must be the student's original work.
- The video interview must be submitted with a completed Video/Photo release form and this category form.
- The video interview cannot be done over the phone and both the student and the senior must appear in the video.
- The student should cover the following three points in the video interview with the senior.
  1. Introduce the senior and a short biography of your relationship.
  2. Share a powerful moment in the senior's life that reflects a Respect Life Issue.
  3. What life advice would the senior like to give young people today?

Respect Life Issues include abortion, adoption, euthanasia, bullying, respect for life, contraception, crisis pregnancy, advocacy for life, stem cell research, just war doctrine, death penalty, suicide, responsibility of Catholic politicians, respectful reproductive technologies, marriage, chastity, rights of the disabled, conscience protection for Catholic Healthcare workers and end of life issues.
