Contest Overview

Level One: Grades 7-8

Teachers & Catechists

- Ensure **all** entries must reflect a **Respect Life issue**, the **contest theme** and **church teaching**
- Encourage originality and adherence to contest rules
- Incorporate contest into school year curriculum

Students

- Submit work that reflects a **Respect Life issue**, the **contest theme** and **church teaching**
- Choose a category and work with your teacher
- Fill out the attached registration form signed

Pastors & Respect Life Leaders

- Communicate with Directors of Religious Education to verify that only one entry per parish is submitted and that entries reflect the contest theme
- Incorporate the contest theme into parish ministries
- Help and guide students with entries

- **Only one entry per category, per school, per parish, for each level can be submitted.** More than one entry in a category will disqualify the school in that category.
- All entries must be accompanied by the attached registration form signed by a parent or guardian, postmarked by **January 25th**, and mailed to the Respect Life Office at **50 North Park Ave, Rockville Centre, NY, 11571.**
- **Teachers and Catechists**-To receive certificates of participation, a list of all students who have entered the contest must be emailed by **January 25th** to dtellis@drvc.org

Cash awards are presented to first, second, and third place winners in each category and each level.

Category Guidelines

Participation in the contest is through any one of the following 7 categories. Choose one category and submissions must **Reference a Respect Life Issue, Reflect the contest theme, and Reflect Church teaching.**

1. Video Design / Student-Senior Citizen Interview Category

- Submit a USB or CD to the Respect Life office
- Video length should not exceed 3 minutes
- Video is to be student's original creation, including filming, editing, and audio
- No PowerPoint presentations or slideshows
- Accompanied by a **Video/Photo release form**
- If choosing to interview a senior citizen:
 - Introduce the senior and explain your relationship
 - Encourage the senior citizen to share a powerful moment in their life that reflects a Respect Life issue
 - Ask what life advice the senior citizen would give to youth today

2. Poetry Category

- Typed in Times New Roman 12 point font and limited to 21 lines
- No images permitted

3. Essay Category

- Single spaced and typed in Times New Roman 12 point font
- Limited to 400 words
- One page with no pictures

4. Bookmark Design Category

- Entries should be hand drawn and submitted **on the bookmark category form**
- Computer generated pictures will not be accepted

5. Music Category

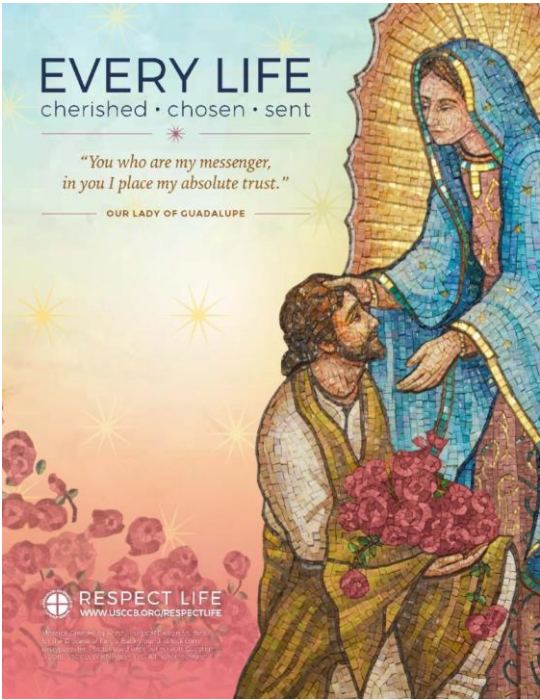
- Lyrics must be the student's original work, but the melody can be in the public domain
- Submit a USB or CD to the Respect Life Office
- Should not exceed 3 minutes
- No video permitted

6. Photography Category

- Image size 8"x10" in color or black & white
- Taken by the student; no collages
- Accompanied by a **completed category form and Video/Photo release form**

7. Mural for Life Category

- For groups up to 4 students with school and names written on back
- Completed on mural paper provided by the Respect Life Office; paper requests should be made no later than **October 22nd to dtellis@drvc.org**
- Must be original creation
- Accompanied by **separate registration forms for each student and one category form for the entire group**
